OVERVIEW

Founded in 1990, the JGBS Alumni Association Inc. of Louisville, Kentucky, connects former students and staff while honoring the heritage and values of the J. Graham Brown School. The Association fosters lifelong relationships, volunteerism, scholarship support, and community engagement, reflecting the school's commitment to kindness, confidence, and a love of learning. Guided by the vision of founder Martha Ellison, who championed an inclusive and student-centered education, the alumni community continues to celebrate diversity, nurture connections, and strengthen ties between the school and the broader community.

FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

The JGBS Alumni Association Inc. manages its financial operations with care and transparency to support scholarships, alumni events, community projects, and operational needs. Strategic fundraising—including annual giving, alumni contributions, and corporate matching—ensures sustainable resources. This year, the Association raised over \$12,000 from alumni donors and achieved a milestone by becoming a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, expanding its fundraising capabilities. Prudent fiscal management and regular reporting ensure funds are effectively allocated to maximize impact for students, alumni, and the broader community.



REVENUE BREAKDOWN

- **Individual Donations:** \$6,030 (up 34% from last year)
- **Corporate Matches:** \$1,000 (down 41% from last year)
- **Fundraising Events:** \$4,978 (up 65% from last year)

EXPENSES

- **Scholarships Awarded:** \$10,000 (down 16% from last year)
- **Operations/Expenses:** \$2008 (up 112% from the previous year)
- **Materials & Supplies:** \$377 (increase from last year)

FUTURE FINANCIAL OUTLOOK

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Looking ahead to 2026, the JGBS Alumni Association is positioned to navigate a dynamic fundraising landscape shaped by both opportunities and challenges. National trends show a decline in donor participation, particularly among smaller donors, underscoring the need for enhanced donor engagement strategies.

In response, the Association will focus on diversifying fundraising strategies and strengthening donor relationships. Emphasizing donor retention, leveraging digital platforms for engagement, and creating innovative fundraising events—such as online auctions and interactive community experiences—are pivotal in sustaining and expanding our donor base.

By aligning with these national trends and adapting to the evolving philanthropic environment, the JGBS Alumni Association aims to ensure continued support for scholarships and community initiatives in the coming year.

TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION

The JGBS Alumni Association is embracing technology to enhance engagement and outreach. Plans include updating the alumni website with a modern design and improved functionality, expanding social media presence, and leveraging additional services from Better World to streamline operations. Efforts will also focus on growing the donor database and broadening reach through platforms like LinkedIn, ensuring stronger connections with alumni and supporters while maximizing fundraising and community engagement opportunities.

ALUMNI ENGAGEMENT

The JGBS Alumni Association is committed to strengthening connections across generations of Brown School graduates. This year's efforts focus on deeper involvement with alumni homecomings, alumni-led community service projects, and new initiatives like an online silent auction. Additionally, the Association is planning smaller, class-based gatherings to foster cross-generational relationships and expand opportunities for alumni to engage meaningfully with one another and the broader community.

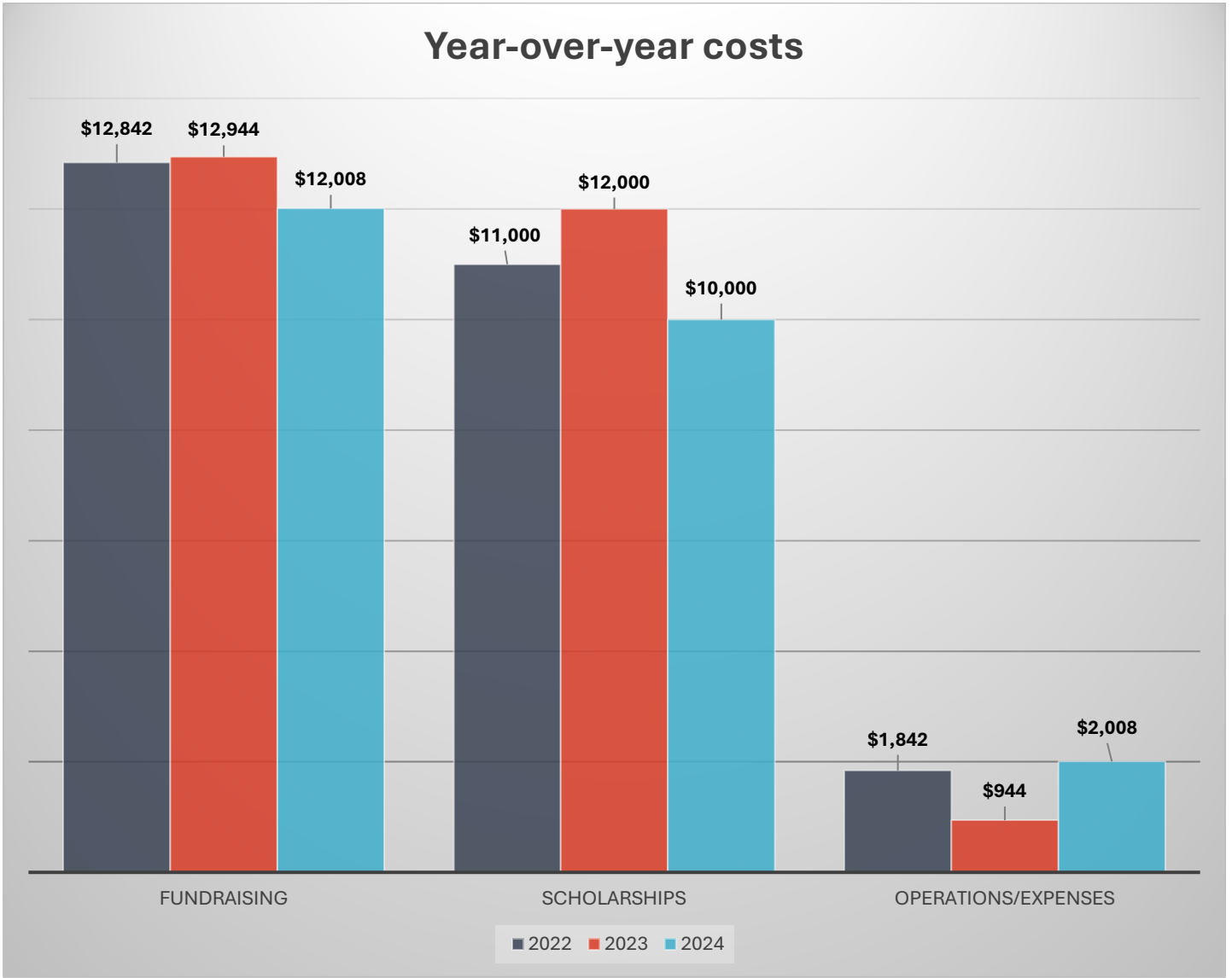
